

### Day 1

Walk through the book.

Look at the front cover, what can you see?

Tell your child the title of the book.

Look through the book and talk about the pictures. There is no reading on this day.

You could ask, "What's on this page....?"

"I wonder what you can see...?"

### Day 2

Look inside the front cover. Go through the sounds and Tricky Words if there are any. "These sounds are going to appear in your book, can you say them?"

Read the book. It's ok to only read half if your child gets tired.

### Day 3

If you read half the book yesterday, recap what happened yesterday and finish the book.

If you read the whole book, read it again.

### Day 4

Read the book again for fluency. Your child should just be able to read it without sounding out. They may have started to memorise the text and that is ok. If they do, make sure they are reading the text at the pace that your finger moves.

### Day 5

Use the questions at the back of the book to work on comprehension skills.

The Tricky Words will look differently now but the principle remains the same.
