### Daily Lessons

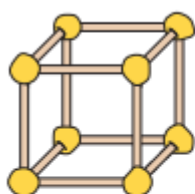

4 long sticks, 8 short sticks 8 balls of clay?

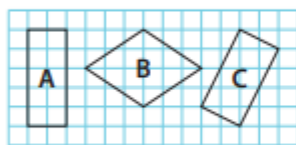
