
**Additional Activities in Support of the White Rose Lessons for this week (if required/desired)****Practical ideas:**

Roll a dice twice to make a two-digit number. (For example - if you roll 2 and 6, you make 26)  
Roll the dice again. This is how many tens you will add. (For example – if you roll a 3, this would be 30.)  
Complete your calculation (For example – this would be  $26+30$ )  
What stays the same? What changes?

Roll a dice twice to make a two digit number, roll twice again to make another two-digit number. Add them together.

**Key Skills – these are to keep the children ticking over (if you have time)**

Mon	<p>Write all the 2-digit numbers greater than 40 using these digits.</p> <div><div>2</div><div>4</div><div>6</div><div>6</div></div> <p>How do you know you have them all? Prove it.</p>
Tues	<p>Place these numbers on the number line: 10, 48, 30</p>  <p>Or for a challenge: Place 47 on each of these empty number lines.</p> <div><div>0100</div><div>4060</div><div>3350</div></div>
Wed	<p>Think of an even number that is more than 30 and less than 50. And another. Can you find them all? How many are there?</p> <p>Explain your reasoning.</p>
