Mon	3 mins TTRS Practise times tables. You could use 'Hit the Button' on Topmarks Maths https://www.topmarks.co.uk/maths-games/hit-the-button Select the times tables game and then you can choose to either 'hit the answer' to the number sentence shown or 'hit the question' that matches the answer. You can choose to practise either specific times tables you need to practise or mixed questions.
Tues	3 mins TTRS Practise doubling numbers. You could use 'Hit the Button' on Topmarks Maths https://www.topmarks.co.uk/maths-games/hit-the-button Select the doubles game. I would suggest playing some of the games on the number range section but you could also practise using multiples of 10, 5 and 50.
Wed	3 mins TTRS Practise halving number. You could use 'Hit the Button' on Topmarks Maths https://www.topmarks.co.uk/maths-games/hit-the-button Select the halves game. I would suggest playing some of the games on the number range section but you could also practise using multiples of 10, 5 and 50.
Thurs	3 mins TTRS Practise number bonds. You could use 'Hit the Button' on Topmarks Maths https://www.topmarks.co.uk/maths-games/hit-the-button Select the number bonds game. I would suggest playing 'make 100' in the up to 100 section but you could play a range of games that you feel confident to.
Fri	3 mins TTRS Practise your division facts. You could use 'Hit the Button' on Topmarks Maths https://www.topmarks.co.uk/maths-games/hit-the-button Select the division facts game and then you can choose to either 'hit the answer' to the number sentence shown or 'hit the question' that matches the answer. You can choose to practise either specific times tables you need to practise or mixed questions.
