Mon	3 mins TTRS Practise telling the time. https://mathsframe.co.uk/en/resources/resource/116/telling-the-time I would suggest working through the different stages of telling the time but starting from where you feel most confident. For example you might start on option 3 'read time to the quarter hour'. Once you have selected the game you would like to play you can decide to practise with either 12 hour or 24 hour clocks. Try to take part in both if you can.
Tues	3 mins TTRS Practise adding pairs to make 1000. https://mathsframe.co.uk/en/resources/resource/549/Addition-Mini-Maths-Golf You can choose to play a short game of 5 questions or along game of 10. Then select 'addition of pairs that make 1000 (multiples of 100)'.
Wed	3 mins TTRS Practise adding pairs to make 100. https://mathsframe.co.uk/en/resources/resource/549/Addition-Mini-Maths-Golf You can choose to play a short game of 5 questions or a long game of 10. Then select 'addition of pairs that make 100'.
Thurs	3 mins TTRS Practise adding 2 and 3-digit numbers together. https://mathsframe.co.uk/en/resources/resource/549/Addition-Mini-Maths-Golf You can choose to play a short game of 5 questions or a long game of 10. Then select 'add combinations of two and three digit numbers'.
Fri	3 mins TTRS Practise a mixture of all of the above from Tuesday. https://mathsframe.co.uk/en/resources/resource/549/Addition-Mini-Maths-Golf You can choose to play a short game of 5 questions or a long game of 10. Then select all three options 'addition of pairs that make 1000 (multiples of 100)', 'addition of pairs that make 100' and 'add combinations of two and three digit numbers'. If this is too difficult, select the game you found hardest to practise again.
