Tues	3 mins TTRS Have a do at halving some numbers: Use https://mathsbot.com/questionsIWB Set topic to 35. Halving, No of questions to 5 – difficulty level min 0, max 2 choose a set of star questions and record your answers in your book. When finished click on solutions to check your answers. If it was too easy, increase the difficulty level.
Wed	3 mins TTRS Have a do at using your number bonds: Use https://mathsbot.com/questionsIWB Set topic to 59. Number Bonds, No of questions to 5 – difficulty level min 0, max 4 choose a set of star questions and record your answers in your book. When finished click on solutions to check your answers. If it was too easy, increase the difficulty level.
Thurs	3 min TTRS Have a go at addition: Use https://mathsbot.com/questionsIWB Set topic to 1. Addition, No of questions to 5 – difficulty level min 0, max 5 choose a set of star questions and record your answers in your book. When finished click on solutions to check your answers. If it was too easy, increase the difficulty level.
Fri	3 min TTRS Have a go at subtraction: Use https://mathsbot.com/questionsIWB Set topic to 5. Subtraction, No of questions to 5 – difficulty level min 0, max 5 choose a set of star questions and record your answers in your book. When finished click on solutions to check your answers. If it was too easy, increase the difficulty level.
